## Understanding the Relational & Triune God:

### Three Acts of God that Changed History:

- A) **The Atonement** (OT: Holy of Holies; NT: Cross)
- B) **The Passover** (OT: Deliverance; NT: Resurrection)
- C) **The Day of Pentecost** (Release of the Holy Spirit)

## The Nature of the Spirit

### The Holy Spirit leads in truth with **INTELLECT**

*What no eye has seen, nor ear heard, nor the heart of man imagined, what God has prepared for those who love him”— these things God has revealed to us through the Spirit. For the Spirit searches everything, even the depths of God. For who knows a person’s thoughts except the spirit of that person, which is in him? So also no one comprehends the thoughts of God except the Spirit of God.*

1 Corinthians 2.9-11 (ESV)

### The Holy Spirit is touched through **EMOTIONS**

*In the same way, the Spirit helps us in our weakness, for we do not know how we should pray, but the Spirit himself intercedes for us with inexpressible groanings.*

Romans 8.26 (NET)

### The Holy Spirit is directed through **WILL**

*But it is one and the same Spirit who does all this [gives spiritual gifts]; as he wishes, he gives a different gift to each person.*

1 Corinthians 12.11 (GNT)

### The Holy Spirit is moved with **COMFORT**

*But the Counselor, the Holy Spirit, whom the Father will send in my name, will teach you all things and will remind you of everything I have said to you.*

John 14.26 (NIV)

### The Holy Spirit seals the **DEAL**

*Having believed, you were sealed with the Holy Spirit of promise.*

Ephesians 1.13 (NKJV)
